### Research papers

Authors from academia, industry, and research institutes are invited to submit abstracts of 400-600 words. The abstract should give an outline of the final paper, indicating the paper's merits and relevance to the symposium scope, a brief account of the results and the conclusions.

When you submit your abstract, please indicate topic or special session.

The final paper should be 6-10 pages long. The required language is English, and all submissions are made electronically. Templates and further instructions will be available at [www.sps2020.se](http://www.sps2020.se).

All submitted abstracts and all full papers will be subject to peer-review by the scientific committee.

For paper acceptance, at least one unique author per paper need to be registered by the early registration deadline.
