You send a recorded presentation to the course leader beforehand and the first day we will have some theory and then analyse and suggest how to change the presentation for the better. Then you have a few days to work with, improve and record a new presentation that we analyse day two. Followed by</p>

an interview with critical scientific questions about your research presentation.
